HOW DO WE RAISE OUR ENTRANCE FEE?

1. Donations from members are a good way to get lodge members involved in a team event. Enthusiasm within the lodge can lead to better participation in general.
2. Donations from local business should be sought. Consider making T-shirts with the names of donors for free advertising for them. Put something in the paper that announces your participation in the race, supporting a youth group and name those businesses who donated as a thank you. It gives you and them exposure. (one year one driver raised \$1,000 through businesses. He made a poster).
3. Have a dinner and use the proceeds for your entrance fee.
